

## Statement of **Environmental Policy** covering the manufacturing facilities of Goodyear Dunlop Tyres UK and Ireland Ltd also trading as Dunlop Motorsport

It is the responsibility of our directors and managers to ensure that this policy is understood, implemented and maintained at all levels within the manufacturing sites, and to ensure that environmental management is given equal priority with all other aspects of management.

Each associate is responsible for complying with this policy and any procedures or instructions that are designed by the company to achieve the requirements of this policy.

The Company acknowledges its responsibility towards its associates and the environment and is committed to the following principles having consideration for economic, financial and relevant technical and environmental requirements of the business:

1. We will comply with the Corporate Environmental Policy and Corporate and relevant standards
2. We will comply with applicable environmental legislation and other requirements to which the company subscribes, that relate to our environmental aspects
3. We will maintain continual improvement of our environmental performance by managing our environmental aspects.
4. We will maintain and improve the environmental awareness of our associates. We will train, teach and coach them concerning environmental impacts related to our processes and products.
5. We will assess significant changes to materials, equipment, processes and site layouts to determine the environmental impacts, and we will minimise their effect by managing them.
6. We will measure, audit, evaluate alternatives, and take technical precautions and corrective action on equipment, and processes, to prevent pollution and minimise emissions, discharges, and other environmental impacts
7. We will communicate emergency procedures and conduct practice drills for dealing with unforeseen incidents.
8. We will review our waste disposal arrangements regularly.
9. We will only consign waste to approved, audited, and legally authorised contractors.
10. We will achieve and maintain zero waste to landfill by reducing waste to a minimum and by adopting recycling initiatives or incineration.
11. We will eliminate the use of solvent in our processes.
12. We will review our energy usage regularly and work constantly to improve energy efficiency.
13. We will inform our suppliers and contractors that it is their duty to comply with environmental legislation.
